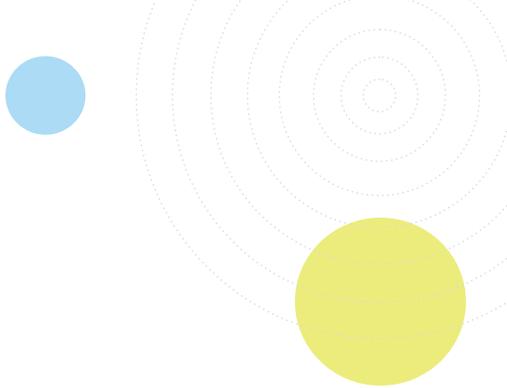

[94% of recruiters](#) using an ATS say it's positively impacted their hiring process. [77% of employees](#) say their positive candidate experience was part of why they accepted their roles.

Although the average time-to-hire has improved in recent years, [it's still 41 days](#) — more than enough time for candidates to lose interest (that only takes a couple of weeks). Combined with an increase in the number of interviews companies are conducting (candidates report eight, nine, and in one case, [29 interviews!](#)), it's clear there's a need for faster hiring processes.

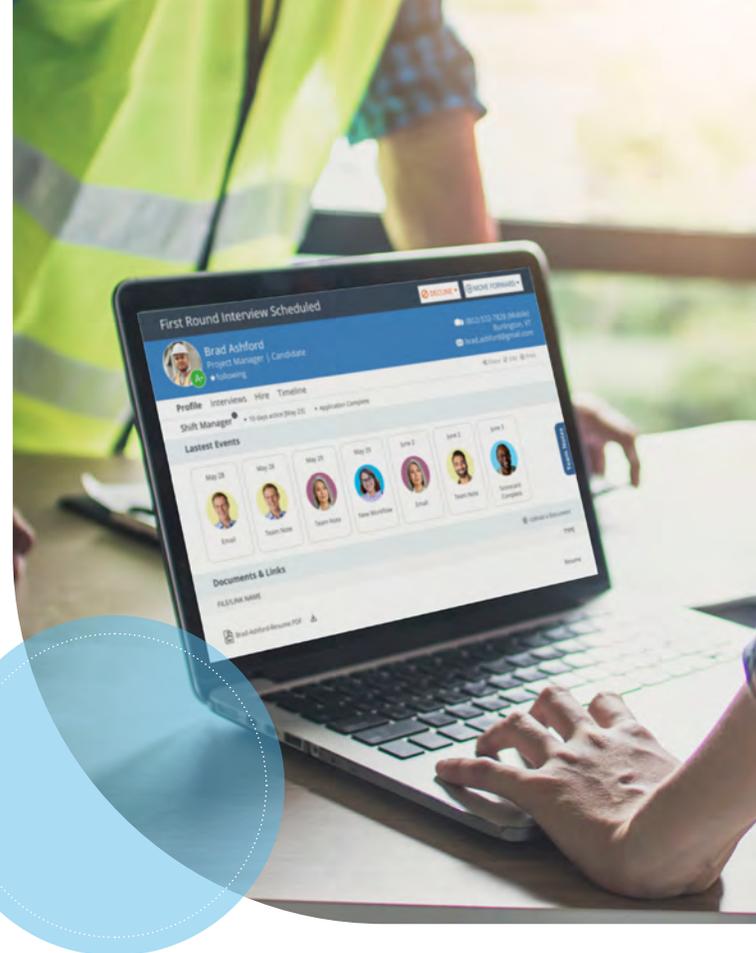

ATS software can solve many common recruiting and hiring problems for your HR team:

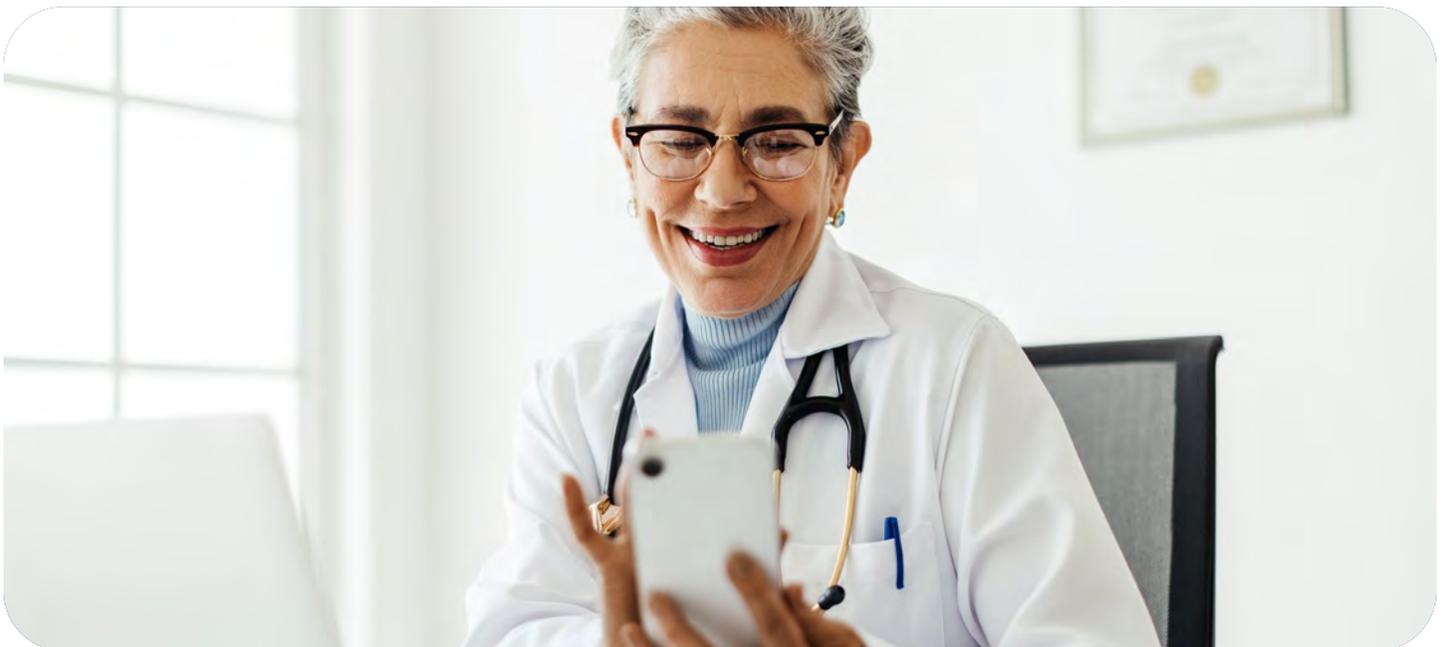

An ATS equipped with AI and talent analytics capabilities is a must-have for HR teams that want to play a part in their company's strategic growth and win at hiring.



43% of HR professionals said upgrading their HR technology to streamline work is a top priority.

There are many reasons to invest in a new applicant tracking system that can help you explain why it's a must-have tool for your team:

- 2 Identify the issues each stakeholder needs the new system to solve.
- 3 Determine which ATS features are need-to-have vs. nice-to-have, and ensure everyone agrees to make the final decision easier.
- 4 Outline the business case for the new applicant tracking system. You'll need to clearly show the problems affecting talent acquisition currently and how an ATS would help solve them. Make sure to include metrics to illustrate your points.

You can use HR metrics like these to support your case:

- 1 HR hours spent on manual recruiting and hiring tasks
- 2 Your current time-to-fill and time-to-hire
- 3 Analyst findings or reports on companies that use an ATS from firms like Gartner
- 4 Data showing the positive impact of an ATS from review sites such as G2 and Software Advice

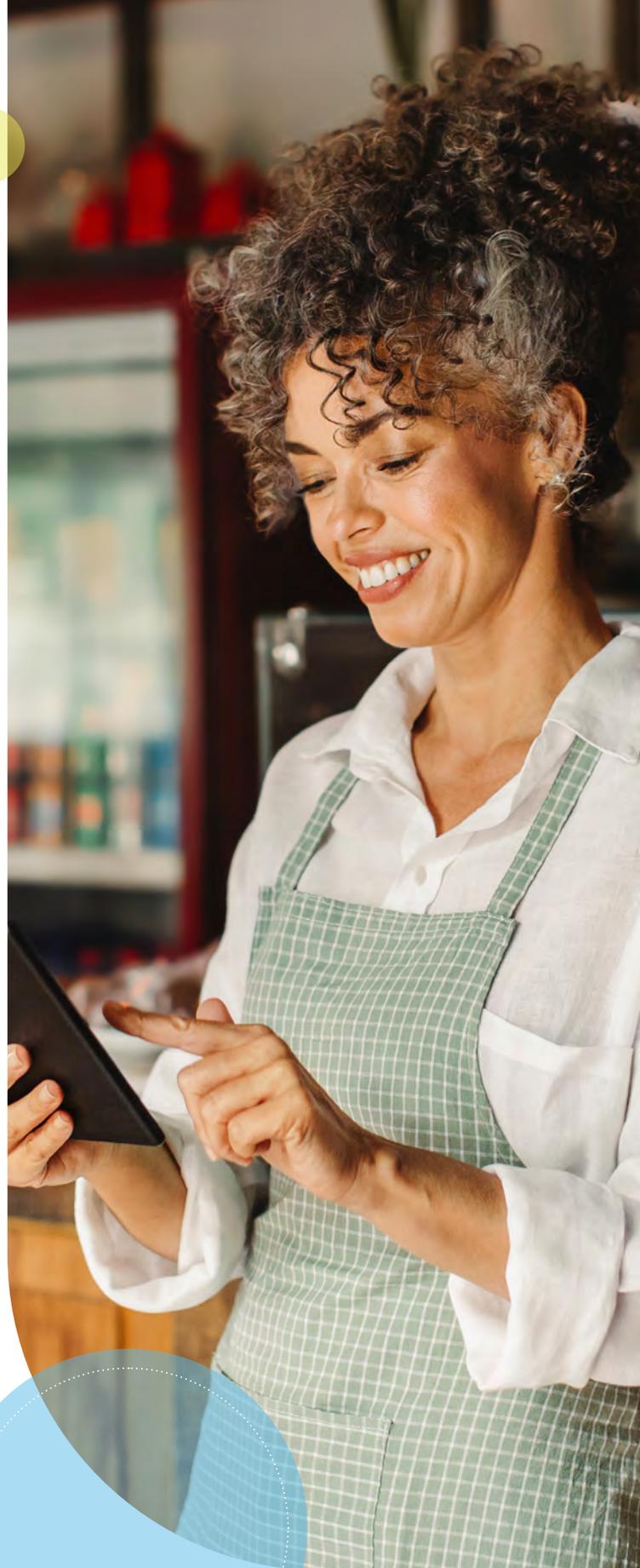

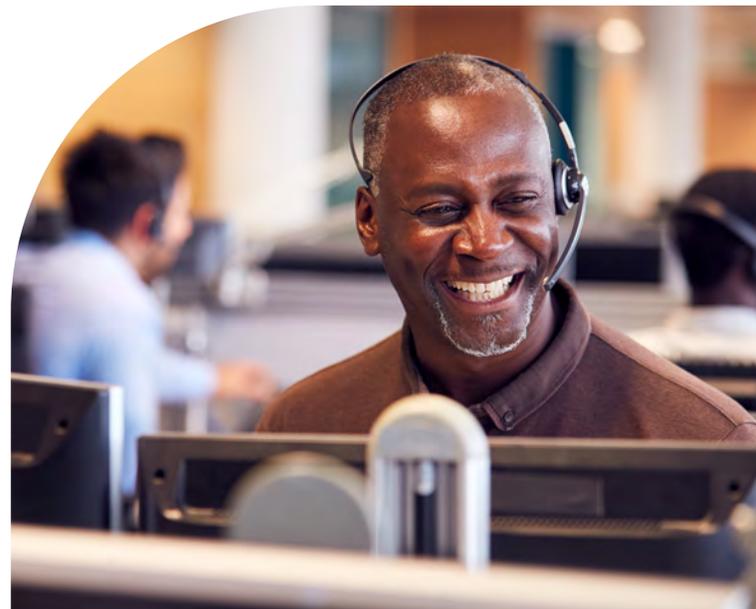

There are lots of factors to consider before investing in a new ATS. Ask the right questions so you can focus on what's important and find the best applicant tracking system for your organization.

We've compiled a list of 41 questions to ask throughout the process to help you choose the right solution.

Recruiting and Hiring Database

Your ATS will handle essential recruiting and hiring data, including sensitive candidate information. You need to know where the data is hosted and how to access it.

Ask the following questions during your demo:

- 1 What is the system hosted on, and is the data file fast, reliable, and scalable?
- 2 How is data exported?
- 3 Can it integrate with other systems?
- 4 What security measures does the system provide to protect candidate data?
- 5 Can role-based access be provided?



Software Flexibility

Every talent acquisition process is different, so how do you know if a vendor can accommodate all of your company's unique needs? Before the demo, share the challenges your team is facing and ask vendors to personalize their walkthrough to your needs.

Ask the following questions during your demo:

- 6 How are applications created?
- 7 How do I manage my job board posts?
- 8 Can you walk me through candidate communication, including texting?
- 9 What do hiring teams see in the software?
- 10 How do Interview Guides and Scorecards work?
- 11 What kinds of communications can I automate?



Integration

You'll need to share candidate data with hiring teams and managers, as well other internal software for those who become employees. Look for an ATS that seamlessly integrates and makes it easy to share information.

Answer these questions before your demo so you can ensure the ATS can meet your needs:

- 12 What information needs to be shared with our other systems?
- 13 Who needs access to talent acquisition data?
- 14 Will any third parties need to have access to talent acquisition data?



User Experience

The applicant tracking system you invest in should have an easy-to-use interface and intuitive user experience. Make sure to consider both your most and least tech-savvy employees.

Ask the following questions:

- 15 Who will use the system, and how much time will they spend using it?
- 16 What is the technology experience level of the average user?
- 17 How does this system accommodate those who aren't as tech-savvy?
- 18 How much time can the business allocate for onboarding and training on the new system?
- 19 How long does it usually take for users to become proficient at using the ATS?



Training & Support

Up-front training for the ATS is necessary, but you should also consider ongoing training for new hires and after new features are released. Can your teams manage training internally, or does the software provider offer training sessions as needed?

Ask the following questions:

- 20 Do you have the budget, bandwidth, and resources to manage training internally, or do you need the system to provide ongoing training?
- 21 What level of training is required for the various roles within your organization?
- 22 Does the system provide the required level of granularity?



Future-Readiness

The system you choose must incorporate your need-to-have functions and should also have the ability to grow to meet the needs of your future workforce. You should also look for an ATS that keeps up with rapid software evolution, offering cutting-edge technology like AI.

Ask the following questions:

- 23 Does the ATS offer AI, automation, and analytics capabilities?
- 24 Which features do we need in the system today?
- 25 Which nice-to-have features will be need-to-have in the future?
- 26 Will this system be able to provide for those needs?

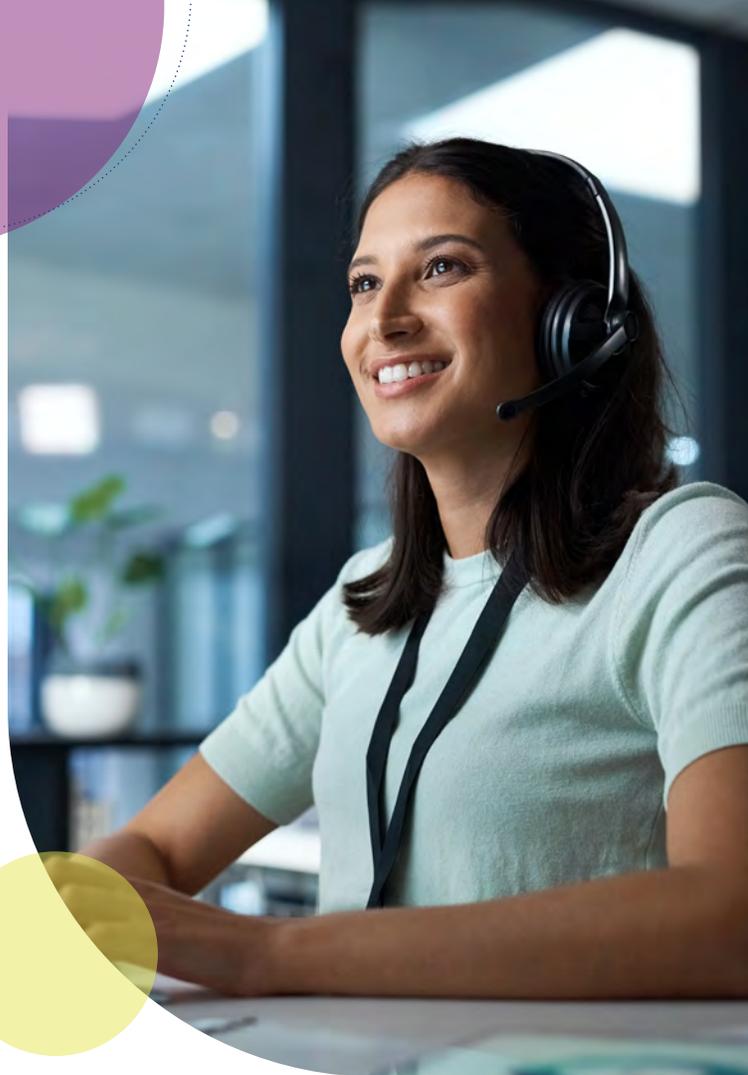


Implementation

Deployment of the new ATS shouldn't disrupt your current system, whether you're moving from a manual process or another vendor. Ensure your new system can retain existing candidate and recruiting data so you don't lose valuable information.

Ask the following questions:

- 27 How can data be transferred and organized into the new system?
- 28 What do we need from the IT department to get the new software up and running and maintain it?





Cost

The typical pricing models for applicant tracking systems are pay-per-user, pay-per-employee, and pay-per-appraisal. Costs may also include implementation or setup fees.

Ask the following questions:

- 29 Which pricing model best fits our budget and needs?
- 30 Which features are included in the monthly or annual price?
- 31 Which features incur extra costs?
- 32 What are typical payment terms?



Vendor

Don't be dazzled by a sleek ATS and a shiny user interface. You'll also want to evaluate the provider itself.

Ask the following questions:

- 33 How long has the vendor been in business, and how many clients use their software?
- 34 What industries does the vendor typically serve?
- 35 What size are most of the businesses the vendor serves?
- 36 Are customer suggestions for software development often accepted or implemented?
- 37 What does a typical customer review say?
- 38 How does the vendor act on negative reviews?
- 39 Has the vendor received any awards?
- 40 How are their technical and customer support functions rated?
- 41 What does their customer support program look like?

Gearing up for ATS Demos

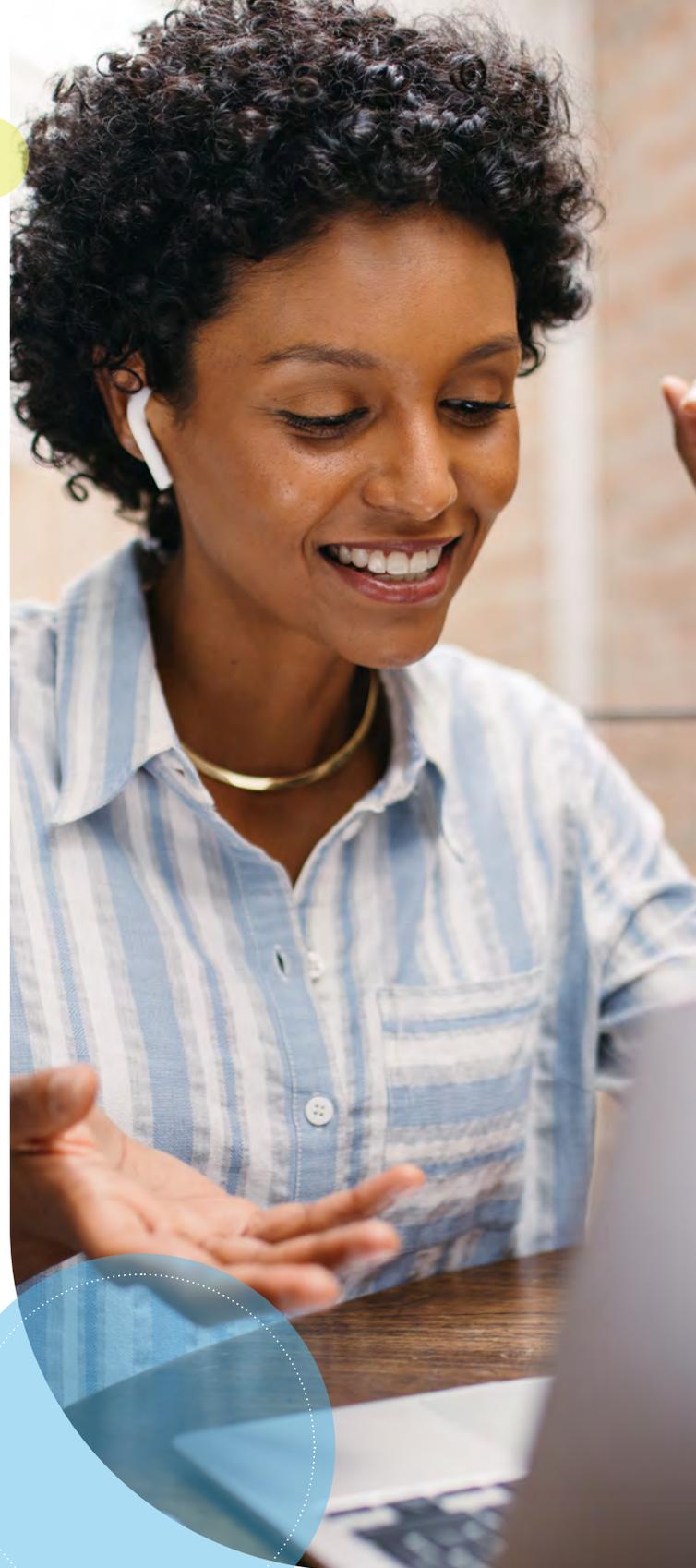
Now, you're ready to determine which software solutions your team will explore. On top of online research, get recommendations from your extended network, and ask your talent acquisition team what they think of your current solutions. Read ATS reviews on sites like G2, Capterra, and SoftwareAdvice.

Gather a list of potential ATS solutions and match each to your list of needs using their feature list or pricing page. Then, schedule demos to see the tool in action. A live, personalized demo (vs. a video recording) will always give you a better idea of whether the ATS suits your team.

Before your demo, create a checklist of desired features and functionalities so you can keep track of the software's pros and cons and save time.

11 Rules for a Successful ATS Demo

- 1 Invite the final decision maker and at least one potential user to attend.
- 2 Have your list of feature expectations handy.
- 3 Take notes (preferably alongside your must-have list).
- 4 Provide a clear overview of your company's needs and challenges for a relevant, personalized demo.
- 5 Be honest about any concerns you have about the ATS.
- 6 Ask questions or repeat a step if you missed it.
- 7 Verify integrations with your other business-critical systems.
- 8 Ask detailed questions about support options and implementation.
- 9 Understand if there are any implementation fees.
- 10 If you don't hear a necessary feature mentioned, ask about it.
- 11 Get concrete costs and pricing information.



Above all, understand that this demo is yours to lead. The vendor knows the product, but you are the expert on your company's needs and expectations.
